Subject: Tariff #8: Rate Changes Effective July 1, 2022

Terminal Labor Services:

On July 1st, 2022, the ILWU/PMA coast contract will expire. Due to labor contract negotiations, the Longshore/Clerk wage and benefit assessments for the ILWU/PMA coast contract are not known at this time. The following tariff rates will increase on July 1, 2022, but may be revised based on results of labor contract negotiations.

- Handling rates to move cargo to and from ship's tackle, increase 10%
- Terminal truck loading and unloading of cargo, increase 10%
- Terminal rail car loading and unloading of cargo, increase 10%
- Labor - hourly rates as published in the tariff, increase approximately 10% (see tariff Item 715)
- Vessel Lines, tie-up and let-go, and dispatcher call-out, increase approximately 10%
